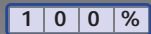


Calibrate Your Battery

In order to get the best performance from your new TruePower battery, the control chip inside needs to be calibrated.

Charge your battery fully after putting it in your machine. You may use your laptop while it is charging. (If you fail to do it immediately, don't panic, follow the steps to recalibrate.)

Once charged, unplug and continue to use your laptop until your battery is completely empty. Reattach your power adapter. You may need to go through 2-3 battery cycles to reach full potential.



Maintain Your Power

To maintain exceptional battery life, we recommend that you re-calibrate your battery every month or so.

With your battery fully charged, unplug and continue to use your laptop until your battery is completely empty. Reattach your power adapter.

It's painless, you can use your computer while doing it and it'll give you more battery life in the long run.



Be Cool

You know that feeling when you're hard at work on your laptop and you start to realize the hair on your legs is being singed o .

Heat. Bad for leg hair. Bad for your battery.

Do what you can to keep your cool. Take breaks. Get a cooling pad. Close a couple of those apps you're not really using.



The Better Life

To get the most out of your battery, here's a few things to do:

- Optimize your battery settings by choosing "Longest Battery Life" in the Energy Settings.
- Set your screen brightness to the lowest comfortable level.
- Close unused applications.
- Eject CDs and DVDs after playing.
- Disconnect unused peripherals.
- When not using AirPort or Bluetooth, turn them o to save power.
